



Overview of Event Requirements

As stated in the Agreement of Commitment, each recipient family is required to plan and execute events in accordance with the amount of grant money placed on their adopted child. Although families are allotted three years to complete these events, we suggest that you get started as early as possible. Some of the events can even take place before your child arrives home. Brittany's Hope has created a list of approved events that families may choose from to fulfill these requirements.

You may choose from any of the following:

1. **Fundraising Event** – Brittany's Hope will provide you with an event plan timeline to help guide you through the planning and execution of any of these fundraisers: car wash, yard/garage sale, themed dinner or party, adoption showcase or welcome home party, ethnic birthday party and sporting events. We are also open to working with you to help plan a fundraiser utilizing your particular talents or skills.
2. **Race-walk** – Every spring, Brittany's Hope Foundation sponsors a Race-walk to raise funds for special needs children around the world. We are hoping to have Race-walks taking place simultaneously across the nation, and recipient families can help us achieve that goal. By hosting a Race-walk in your hometown you are helping us to bring joy to another child, and another family's life. Again, we are willing to help you along the way by providing you with a timeline and other support materials to get you started.
3. **Brittany's Cribs** – Formerly known as Cribs for Kids, Brittany's Cribs is a special project that raises funds to provide children in orphanages with proper cribs and mattresses. The money that is raised also supplies children with a "busy box" which provides them with the necessary stimuli to help them grow and mature. You can raise money for the cribs campaign through involvement with your local church or elementary school. Brittany's Hope will provide you with materials you need to begin this project.
4. **Speeches** – Public speaking may be the number one fear of people in the United States, but it is also one of the most effective ways to spread information and to raise funds. Speeches are also a quick way to fulfill your event requirements, but they do require effort. Brittany's Hope can guide you through the process, from planning to speaking, through our speech kit.
